
How *blessed* we all are to live and thrive in this place.

Kitchen Remodel

You may be hearing rumors of a kitchen remodel at Riverside. Well, yes, it just might happen!

Ever since I joined Riverside about 6 years ago there has been talk about needing to upgrade our kitchen. The talks have gotten more serious this year as we have been looking at ways Riverside could better serve the community. So many of our Christian teachings and traditions center on food, and so Food and Faith programs seem a natural extension as who we are as a Riverside family.

As our discussions progressed God sent us two gifts. First, Kathy Watson (owner and chef of Nora's Kitchen) stepped forward with a plan for how we could transform our existing space into a commercial kitchen. She has offered consulting services to the project and has introduced us to the contractors and supplies who built her two restaurant kitchens.

The second gift comes in the form of funding. Before his death, Scott Johnson called me and said he and Elaine would pay for the kitchen. For obvious reasons, they wanted the project to begin immediately. At their request a series of meetings took place before Scott died. Elaine wants this project to move forward and she humbly agreed that when completed this will be The Scott & Elaine Johnson Kitchen @ Riverside Church.




